

OLYMPIC TORCH

The Olympic Torch is redesigned for every Olympic games. Its flame is lit in Olympia in Greece, the site of the original Olympic games, a few months before the games take place.

The torch then makes its important journey to the opening ceremony in the host country, where it lights the Olympic cauldron. This flame stays alight for the whole of the Olympic games.



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut out the shape on the next page. This will be your torch holder. You can paint or colour this in first.
2. Now curl this around into a cone. Attach it together using tape or a stapler.
3. Next, cut out the flames and attach them to the inside of the cone. Get creative and add glitter, tissue paper or anything you like to the holder or flame to make it unique.
